ALPE ADRIA TOUR VILLACH -GRADO



ITALY

DESCRIPTION

The starting point of this bike tour is Villach, situated on the edge of the Klagenfurt basin, where the rivers Drau and Gail flow together. Soon, however, it is time to say goodbye to Austria, before the cycling tour continues in Italy. The Friuli-Venezia Giulia region not only offers a variety of landscapes, but also invites you on a journey through the cultural diversity of the region. This mix of cultures is also reflected in the kitchen: Alpine-Austrian, Slovenian and Venetian influences characterise the gastronomic offer of the region. Leaving the peaks of the Carnic Alps far behind, you will cycle towards the sea on the southern side of the Alps. In front of you the Adriatic coast will stretch with miles of sandy beaches. The tour from Villach to Trieste is an easy tour. It goes along bike paths or very quiet side roads, through small villages and picturesque landscape.

DETAILED ROUTES

Day 1: Villach

Individual arrival at the starting-hotel in Villach. Parking place close to the hotel available. (During the period of the Villacher Kirchtag no arrival and overnight in Villach possible; alternatively arrival and overnight in Spittal a.d. Drau - train ticket Spittal a.d. Drau - Villach incl.)

Day 2: Villach – Malborghetto

(approx. 50 km)

Following the river Gail, you leave Villach behind and soon you also say goodbye to Austria and welcome Italy. In the border triangle of Italy-Austria-Slovenia stretches the Canal Valley, whose centre is the Italian border town of Tarvis. Austrians, Slovenes, Friulians and Italians have lived together here for centuries and all three major European language families - Germanic, Romanic and Slavic - meet directly here.

Day 3: Malborghetto - Udine

(approx. 79 km)

While cycling through the Canal Valley, you will admire the beauties of the Friulian Alpine region with its intact, untouched nature and extensive forests from the saddle. The small town of Gemona del Friuli, situated at the southern exit of the Canal Valley and at the foothills of the Julian Alps, is considered one of the most beautiful historic towns in Friuli Venezia Giulia. The town is dominated by the majestic Santa Maria Assunta Cathedral, which is certainly worth a visit. Wine dominates today' s stage. Hills full of vines line your path and invite you to taste a drop or two. Udine, characterised by Venetian influences, radiates calm and tranquillity; you can admire important late Gothic and Renaissance buildings while having a coffee in the "piazza" or strolling through the city centre.

Day 4: Udine - Grado

(approx. 55 km)

Accompanied by the breeze of the Scirocco, you glide past reed landscapes and water channels and arrive in Grado, a historic fishing town and one of the most popular seaside resorts on the Adriatic.

Day 5: Grado

Individual departure from Grado or possibility to extend your stay on the Adriatic Sea.


