






CYCLING ALONG THE PROSECCO ROUTE, IN THE GROWING AREA OF THE RENOWNED PEARL WINE

DESCRIPTION

Cycling in the Prosecco region is absolutely the best way to know this region framed in the north by the Alps and in the south by the river Piave, where green hills are covered by lush overgrown vineyards. What is waiting for you is a land full of charme, history and art, enriched by unexpected surprises bearing witness to its ancient past: fairy castles, aristocratic villas but also typical cellars where local people are keeping alive the pleasure of hospitality... You will absolutely need to taste their delicious local products! In this area the winemaking tradition has ancient roots; the first written evidence of Prosecco dates back to 1772 and nowadays, even though sparkling wines are widespread throughout the whole country, only the product born from these particular graves, with its floral and fruity scent, can bring in the world the name of „Prosecco“. An easy/medium cycling tour suitable good for everybody, following good cycle paths and secondary roads far from heavy traffic.

DETAILED ROUTES

Day 1: Arrival in Vittorio Veneto

Individual arrival at the hotel in Vittorio Veneto.

Day 2: Vittorio Veneto - Valdobbiadene

(approx. 38 km)

Today's stage alternates between nature and culture. At the beginning you cycle from Vittorio Veneto past Lake Revine in Valmareno between the hills of Treviso and the Venetian Prealps. Then you cycle amidst green woods, beech and chestnut trees above the village of Follina, one of the most beautiful villages in Italy. We strongly recommend a stop at the Osteria Senz'Ostea famous place with a unique charm. From the top you have a 180-degree panorama over the characteristic hills where the vineyards grow on steep slopes.

Day 3: Valdobbiadene - Bassano del Grappa

(approx. 45 km)

Starting in Valdobbiadene, the stage takes you through many small, cosy towns that invite you to stop and have a bite to eat. You cycle to Bassano del Grappa, which is located to the south at the foot of Monte Grappa. The town takes its name from this mountain. The numerous grappa distilleries here are interesting. Be sure to see the famous wooden bridge „Ponte degli Alpini“ in Bassano del Grappa.

Day 4: Bassano del Grappa - Asolo - Pieve di Soligo

(approx. 71 km)

Today's stage takes you from Bassano del Grappa first to Asolo, which is situated on a hill. Asolo is famous for its Asolo Prosecco. From Asolo you cycle comfortably up and down to Susegana. The landscape is completely surrounded by vineyards, small villages, typical taverns and wine cellars. Shortly after Susegana, you cycle past the grandiose complex of the San Salvatore Castle at Collalto before reaching Pieve di Soligo, the stage destination. Due to its favourable geographical position, Pieve di Soligo is also called „the pearl of the Piave district“.

Day 5: Pieve di Soligo - Conegliano - Vittorio Veneto

(approx. 45 km)

You cycle from Pieve di Soligo above Refrontolo to Molinetto della Croda - an old water mill from the 17th century, which you should definitely visit. The stage continues through vineyards and typical taverns to Corbanese, San Pietro di Feletto and Rua di Feletto to Conegliano. For Conegliano you should take enough time to get to know the town better. Conegliano is the second largest town in the province after the capital Treviso and is a crossroads between Venice, Udine and Cortina.

Day 6: Departure

Individual departure or possibility to extend your stay.
