DESCRIPTION

The European long-distance hiking trail E5 crosses the Alps from north to south. The hiking trail runs from Constance on Lake Constance to Verona. It has an approximate length of 600 kilometers and crosses several countries - including Germany, Austria, Switzerland and Italy.

DETAILED ROUTES

P Day 1: Arrival

Individual arrival in Merano

Pay 2: Merano - Moos im Passeier - Merano

(approx. 6 hours)

The Passeier Valley, home of the Tyrolean folk hero Andreas Hofer, is one of the most rustic and scenically diverse valleys in South Tyrol.

Pay 3: Merano - San Genesio - Bolzano

(approx. 6 hours)

You have a magnificent panoramic view of the silhouette of the famous Dolomite peaks to the east and the Ötztal and Sarntal Alps to the north.

Pay 4: Bolzano - Bauernkohlern - Nova Ponente/Deutschnofen/Weißenstein

(approx. 5.5 hours)

On this stage you can discover the beauty of Bolzano from a privileged position. You leave the northern section of the E5 and hike through woods and meadows towards the southern section.

P Day 5: Deutschhofen/Weißenstein - Truden

(approx. 5.5 hours)

Starting from the pilgrimage site of Maria Weißenstein, you hike further into the Kössertal valley and into the Bletterbachschlucht gorge, a UNESCO World Heritage Site around 400 meters deep.

P Day 6: Truden - Gfrill

(approx. 5 hours)

You hike along the provincial border of South Tyrol, where you have an excellent view down into the Adige Valley.

Pay 7: Gfrill - Cembra - Trento

(approx. 5 hours)

You hike through quiet and secluded mixed oak forests on well-marked paths from South Tyrol directly across the border into Trentino. You will often cross this border without realizing it. The hike takes you past the Bait dei Tinoti on the ridge to Lago Santo, a shimmering blue lake in the middle of the dark green forest. With the public bus you reach Trento.

P Day 8: Departure

Individual departure or possibility to extend your stay.

By plane: The nearest airports are Innsbruck (approx. 83 km), Verona Villafranca (approx. 191 km), Treviso (approx. 228 km), Venice Marco Polo (approx. 313 km).
